

The meeting of the Burlington County Tax Board was held virtually via GoToMeeting teleconference due to COVID-19 restrictions.

The County Tax Administrator opened the meeting at 9:00 am and explained the meeting was being held pursuant to notices advertised and posted in conformance with the Open Public Meeting Act.
