

The meeting of the Burlington County Tax Board was held virtually via GoToMeeting teleconference due to COVID-19 restrictions.

The County Tax Administrator opened the meeting at 9:06 am and explained the meeting was being held pursuant to notices advertised and posted in conformance with the Open Public Meeting Act.

Commissioners Foote, Holley, Kennedy and Valenzano were all present for this meeting and answered roll call.

The potential re-organization process and resolutions presented were discussed with new board members to ensure everyone was in agreement to move forward with the business of the board.

Commissioners agreed to open the meeting to the public – Mr. Kent Pipes addressed the board regarding his concerns of inequity in Mt. Holly. He will send the information to the Administrator that he referenced so that the matter can be discussed and reviewed at a later date.

All Commissioners agreed to move forward with re-organization and business before the board. The County Tax Administrator called for nominations for Tax Board President and Vice President.

Nomination of Commissioner Kennedy for Board President by Commissioner Foote, seconded by Commissioner Holley. Hearing no other nominations, roll call: All were in favor.

Nomination of Commissioner Holley for Board Vice President by Commissioner Kennedy, seconded by Commissioner Foote. Hearing no other nominations, roll call: All were in favor.

Business before the Board:

Commissioner Holley made a motion to approve Resolution 2020-2, establishing the 100% County ratio, seconded by Commissioner Valenzano. All were in favor, motion carried.

Commissioner Holley made a motion to approve Resolution 2020-3, authorizing the Tax Board Administrator to strike and certify tax rates, seconded by Commissioner Foote. All were in favor, motion carried.

Commissioner Foote made a motion to approve the amended 202 final equalization table, seconded by Commissioner Holley. All were in favor, motion carried.

The meeting was opened to public comment, hearing none, an announcement was made that the next Board Meeting will be July 31 at 9am. (later postponed until August 10th)

Commissioner Holley made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Commissioner Foote. All were in favor, motion carried at 9:41 am.
