**KENNEDY WAY IN WILLINGBORO SCHEDULED FOR RESURFACING**

**Construction on 2.1-Mile Section Of County Road Set To Begin Monday**

Resurfacing of a 2.1-mile portion of Kennedy Way (CR633) from Beverly-Rancocas Road (CR626) in Willingboro to Salem Road (CR688) in Burlington Township is expected to begin Monday, July 18.

The project involves milling and overlay, and is expected to take about two weeks to complete. Traffic will be maintained during construction and motorists are encouraged to seek alternative routes during the work.

Construction is being performed by Neshaminy Constructors, Inc. / American Asphalt Co., Inc. – A Joint Venture, West Collingswood, as part of the County's 2010 State Funded Overlay Program.

A total 29.7 miles of County roads in 17 municipalities are being resurfaced through the \$6.8M program.
