RESURFACING RANCOCAS ROAD SCHEDULED TO START MONDAY

1.5-Mile Stretch From Mt. Holly Bypass to Irick Road Expected To Take 3 Weeks

The resurfacing of a 1.5-mile portion of Rancocas Road (County Route 626) in Westampton is scheduled to begin Monday, May 2, it has been announced.

Construction involves milling and overlay of Rancocas Road from Mount Holly Bypass (CR541) to Irick Road (CR637). The project expected to take about three weeks to complete.

Traffic will be maintained with one lane alternating, but motorists may experience delays and are advised to seek alternative routes during construction.

The contractor for the project is Neshaminy Constructors, Inc./American Asphalt Co., Inc. – A Joint Venture of West Collingswood. The construction is part of the County's 2010 State Funded Overlay Program.

A total 29.7 miles of County roads in 17 municipalities are being resurfaced through the \$6.8M program.
