REPAVING SET FOR JULIUSTOWN-BROWNS MILLS ROAD IN PEMBERTON

Construction on 2.5-Mile Section Of County Road Scheduled To Begin Monday

Milling and repaving of a 2.5-mile section of Juliustown-Browns Mills Road (County Route 669) between Pemberton-Browns Mills Road (CR530) and Pointville Road (CR630) in Pemberton Township is scheduled to begin Monday, June 13.

Traffic will be maintained with one lane alternating during construction, which is expected to take two weeks to complete. Motorists should anticipate delays during construction and are advised to seek alternative routes.

Construction is being performed by Neshaminy Constructors, Inc. / American Asphalt Co., Inc. – A Joint Venture, West Collingswood, as part of the County's 2010 State Funded Overlay Program.

A total 29.7 miles of County roads in 17 municipalities are being resurfaced through the \$6.8M program.
