RIVER ROAD IN BURLINGTONS SCHEDULED FOR RESURFACING

Construction on 1.8-Mile Section Of County Route 656 Set To Begin Tuesday

Resurfacing of a 1.8-mile portion of River Road (County Route 656) in Burlington Township and Burlington City is expected to begin Tuesday, September 6.

The project involves milling and overlay of River Road, also known as Delaware Avenue and Pearl Street, from Neck Road (CR658) in Burlington Township to Assiscunk Creek in Burlington City. The work is expected to take about two weeks to complete.

Traffic will be maintained during construction and motorists are encouraged to seek alternative routes during the work.

Construction is being performed by Neshaminy Constructors, Inc. / American Asphalt Co., Inc. – A Joint Venture, West Collingswood, as part of the County's 2010 State Funded Overlay Program.

A total 29.7 miles of County roads in 17 municipalities are being resurfaced through the \$6.8M program.
