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BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION ON GARDEN STATE PARKWAY RESCHEDULED

Overnight Closure of Route 9 in Bass River Planned for Sept. 19

The Engineer's Office in the County Department of Public Works has announced a postponement of the overnight closing of Route 9 in Bass River to Wednesday, September 19th beginning at 10 p.m. Route 9 will reopen at 5 a.m. Thursday, Sept. 20.

Continuing recent storms related to Hurricane Irene forced the cancellation of the construction originally scheduled for Sept. 5.

The NJ Turnpike Authority is constructing a new bridge over Route 9 along the Garden State Parkway as part of its GSP widening project. When completed, the new bridge will carry northbound GSP traffic over Route 9 while the existing bridge will carry southbound traffic over Route 9.

The Route 9 closing is between North Maple Avenue (County Route 655) and East Greenbush Road (CR654). Pouring a concrete deck on the new Parkway bridge will require closing Route 9.

A detour for cars will be posted from Route 9 west to North Maple Avenue to Stage Road (CR655) to East Greenbush Road. A separate detour will be posted for trucks using the Garden State Parkway.
