Most donation centers will take gently used clothing, linens, towels, hats and handbags, shoes (important-tie shoes in pairs).

Material and items must be DRY and mildew-free.

What about textiles too worn to be re-worn?

You can donate DRY, NON-MILDEWED textiles that are worn or stained that you deem unusable at any Goodwill Donation Center. Attach a piece of paper to the bag/box that says "Salvage." It will go to the salvage division where it will be baled and shipped off to be made into industrial rags.

Schools can work with a donation agency on end of year locker cleanouts.
