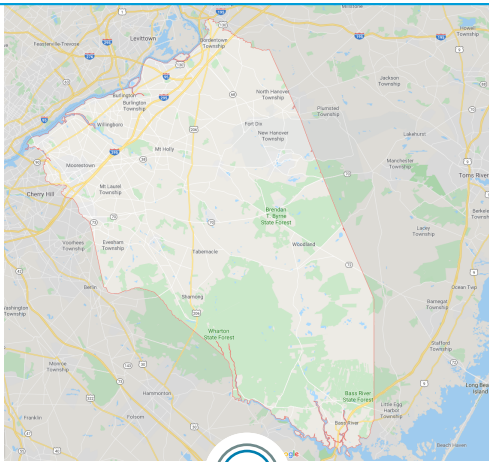

The Burlington County Youth Services Advisory Council serves as a primary advisory board related to youth at risk or involved with the Family Court, Probation, or Parole.

The YSAC has been planning services for court involved youth since the mid 1980's.

Our mission is to plan and fund programs for youth to prevent, divert or redirect them from juvenile justice involvement.
