

Using your paper cart is easy!

- Put all paper and cardboard in the cart.
- Flatten and fold boxes to fit into your cart. If they won't fit, flatten and stack neatly next to your cart, or take to your town dropoff.
- Put shredded paper in small boxes or paper bags before placing in your cart.
- Place your cart curbside by 6am.
- **The lid opening MUST FACE THE STREET**



NOTE: CARTS THAT CONTAIN TRASH OR BOTTLES & CANS WILL NOT BE EMPTIED!

What can you put in the cart?

Paper and Cardboard ONLY!
READ THE LABEL ON THE INSIDE OF THE CART LID.



DO NOT RECYCLE

NO hardback books, foil-coated or food contaminated boxes or refrigerated/frozen food cartons.



Common questions

- Q:** Can I put bottles, cans and cartons in my cart?
- A:** NO – A different truck collects them. Keep using your recycling bucket for bottles, cans and cartons until Single Stream starts later this fall; you can recycle juice, milk and soup paper cartons, but **put them in your bucket** with bottles and cans.
- Q:** What about large oversized boxes like appliance or furniture boxes?
- A:** Consider using your town dropoff. If necessary, fold or cut boxes to fit in the cart. If you must, set them next to the cart.
- Q:** Where should I put my cart?
- A:** Keep **AT LEAST** 3 feet of clear space around your cart. Avoid utility poles, mailboxes, fire hydrants, trees, cars, trash and recycling containers. Place your cart within 1 foot of the curb.
- Q:** Why does the lid opening need to face the street?
- A:** The truck's automated arm cannot turn the cart around. If the cart is dumped "backwards," the lid can be torn off.
