What is a Fixed Facility?

- ◆ Private Industry (minimum number of employees = 100)
- ◆ Local / County /Federal facilities
- ◆ Service Sector (public utilities, electric, water, etc.)
- ◆ Correctional Facilities
- ◆ Residential Care facilities
- ◆ Colleges and Universities
- ◆ Physician Practices

What is the Fixed Facility Plan?

- ◆ A medication distribution system for employees of fixed facilities, and their household members, activated during a natural or man-made event

Overall Medication Distribution Plan:

- ◆ Allocations of medications will be prioritized based on the epidemiology of the event, need and availability
- ◆ Initial quantities of medications will be directed to the first responder community
- ◆ Subsequent quantities of medications will be allocated to Point of Dispensing (POD) sites, which will include General Public sites, and fixed facility sites

Concept of Operations

- ◆ Establish infrastructure for rapid distribution of medication to targeted population
- ◆ Medication delivery: Federal to State to Health Department to Facility
- ◆ Fixed facility provides total numbers to Burlington County Health Department (BCHD)
- ◆ Numbers will be multiplied by 5 by BCHD to account for household members

Fixed Facility Responsibilities

1. Complete Letter of Understanding
2. Develop distribution plan
3. Establish facility points of contact (three-deep)
4. Identify distribution personnel
5. Provide numbers to BCHD
6. Identify all distribution sites and resources
7. Enrollment in BCHD Medical Reserve Corps*
8. Attend trainings *
9. Provide security as necessary

Distribution Personnel

- ◆ Individuals designated to distribute medications to employees/residents
- ◆ Enroll in Burlington County Medical Reserve Corps
- ◆ Attend annual training sessions

- ◆ Private Industry (100 plus employees)
- ◆ Fixed Facility Responsibilities: – Point Of Contact, Distribution Plan, Training, Security
- ◆ Distribution personnel need to enroll in the Burlington County Medical Reserve Corps
