



ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

FLAMMABLES *such as –*

- Petroleum Distillates
- Paint Thinner
- Oil-based Paint
- Spot Remover
- Adhesives
- Automotive Products

TOXICS *such as –*

- Rust Remover
- Paint Remover
- Pool Chemicals
- Weed Killer
- Acids
- Photographic Chemicals

LEAD ACID BATTERIES

- Moped, Truck, Motorcycle, Car, Marine and Laptop

PESTICIDES, INSECTICIDES & HERBICIDES *such as –*

- DDT
- Chlordane
- Flea powder
- Sevin
- Malathion

CORROSIVES *such as –*

- Oven Cleaner
- Household Lye
- Ammonia-based Cleaners
- Acids
- Driveway Cleaner

LATEX PAINT –

*is water-based and not hazardous;
if nearly empty, let dry and
place in trash with LID OFF.*

HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES

- Rechargeable batteries found in everyday devices from cell phones and tablets to cordless tools, cameras and toys.
(Can also be recycled at Home Depot & Lowes)
(Alkalines are not hazardous and can be disposed of as trash)

ADDITIONAL ITEMS

- Used Motor Oil and Antifreeze
- Fluorescent Tubular Lamps
(Compact fluorescent bulbs can be recycled at Home Depot & Lowes)
