The Burlington County Sheriff's Department has joined "Project Lifesaver" along with numerous other law enforcement agencies across the country.


Project Lifesaver protects individuals who may wander, and gives peace of mind to caregivers, families and communities.

Project Lifesaver is an innovative rapid response program aiding victims and families suffering from Alzheimer's disease, Dementia and similar disorders such as Down syndrome and Autism. Patients are equipped with a wrist worn radio transmitter, and if they are reported missing, special law enforcement teams respond with tracking equipment to help locate and safely return them home.

The Burlington County Sheriff's Department has partnered with police departments in Bordentown Township, Burlington Township, Chesterfield, Florence, Mansfield, Mount Laurel and Palmyra to provide quick and immediate 24/7 response throughout Burlington County, to help ensure the safe return of your loved one.
