MANDATORY E-WASTE RECYCLING



State law mandates that **TVs, computers, computer monitors, laptops, tablets and now printers and fax machines** must be taken to an e-waste recycling dropoff.

DO NOT SET THEM OUT FOR TRASH OR PUT IN CURBSIDE RECYCLING.

E-WASTE RECYCLING OPTIONS FOR COUNTY RESIDENTS:

Burlington County Resource Recovery Complex

(Monday-Friday 7am-5pm / Saturday 7am-Noon)
County Residents only, no businesses or non-profits.

Accepts the mandatory **e-waste items above** and other common e-waste including keyboards, DVD and mp3 players.

Goodwill Donation Centers

Accept the mandatory **e-waste items above** for responsible recycling. Visit their website for locations. *No businesses or large quantities.*

Stores

- All Best Buy stores accept mandated e-waste, but charge a fee for TV recycling. For details visit the e-waste page on their website.
- All Staples stores accept mandated e-waste except for TVs and CRT monitors. For details, visit their e-waste page on their website.

Municipal E-waste Dropoffs

For their residents only - Bordentown City, Cinnaminson, Delran, Evesham, Florence, Maple Shade, Medford Twp., Mt. Laurel, Pemberton Twp., Shamong, Tabernacle and Wrightstown

Note - the e-waste accepted varies by town - visit their website for details.

Now is the time to **RECYCLE RIGHT**

Outbound shipments of recycled materials to recycling mills across the globe are now subject to new purity standards that are extremely difficult to meet. For many recycling programs this has meant higher costs and items ending up in the landfill. With additional measures at the recycling center and with our 'Recycle Right' initiative, Burlington County is meeting this challenge for now; but we must do better. Please continue to help us by following the guidelines below.

RECYCLE:

Paper and Flattened Cardboard



Plastic Bottles and Food Containers

Empty and rinse containers.



Glass Bottles and Jars

Labels are okay!



Metal CANS Only

Other metal items can harm workers and equipment.



Cartons



SET RECYCLING OUT BY 6 AM

Metal bar must face the street.

DO NOT RECYCLE:

NO hoses or hangers

NO hardback books, food soiled, or frozen food boxes

NO foil items, bulbs, glassware, or window glass

NO motor oil or hazardous items

NO plastic with a  (like Styrofoam)

NO plastic bags or wrap

NO needles

NO plant pots, trays, lids, or cups

NO shredded paper
