FREE DEFENSIVE DRIVING CLASSES AVAILABLE

Wednesdays and Saturdays Each Month with Updated Info

The Burlington County Sheriff's Department has openings for their updated Defensive Driving Classes held each month on Wednesdays and Saturdays.

Classes are held from 8:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. at the County Emergency Services Training Center, 53 Academy Drive in Westampton.

The course is free and open to any county resident with a valid NJ driver's license.

Sheriff Jean Stanfield noted that the curriculum has just been updated by the NJ State Safety Council to include more information on distracted driving and accident statistics.

Eligible persons can receive a minimum 5 percent discount on their car insurance or a two-point reduction on their NJ Division of Motor Vehicle driving record if they certify they have completed the course.

A \$10 money order made payable to the NJ State Safety Council is required to receive the certificate. No checks or cash will be accepted.

Registration is required as class size is limited. Funding is provided by a grant from the Division of Highway Traffic Safety.
