## **Code Blue To Remain In Effect Through Wednesday, January 12th**

### **For Emergency Sheltering, Call CONTACT 856-234-8888**

As a result of anticipated cold weather conditions and forecasts, the Burlington County Health Department today declared that the current Code Blue Cold Weather Emergency will remain in effect through 12 Noon Wednesday, January 12, 2011. Officials will then review and assess upcoming weather forecasts.

A Code Blue declaration is made in Burlington County when winter conditions pose a threat of serious harm or death to individuals without shelter. When a Code Blue is enacted it provides for short-term emergency sheltering.
