Courthouse Security Screening Process

comprehensive to ensure that no weapons, explosives or any other dangerous items can be brought into any judicial facility. All persons entering a courts building must undergo security screening, which includes

x-ray of all packages, purses, briefcases and any other containers, and metal detectors and hand scanners to scan each individual who enters the facility. litigant, attorney, off-duty law enforcement officer and employee will be screened prior to gaining admittance to judicial buildings.
