### Farm Fair

Held each year in July, the Burlington County Farm Fair is a highlight of the year for many county 4-H'ers. Clubs and members can participate in a variety of ways to showcase their accomplishments and projects with the public and with other 4-H'ers.

### Public Presentations

Public presentations are a great way to learn how to speak before a group without being afraid. An event is held so members can be recognized for their efforts. County public presentations are usually held in April and state presentations are held in June. A presentation is done once a year by a 4-H'er through Illustrated Talk, Demonstration, Formal Speech or Performing Arts.

Members of the Burlington County 4-H Cloggers Club demonstrate how to give an effective public presentation at a workshop designed for beginners as well as advanced presenters. Helpful hints and a training guide are supplied for all participants. Two adult leaders or parent volunteers from each club are required to attend with their club members.

The quilt raffle is an annual fundraiser to provide support for teen leadership opportunities such as Citizenship Washington Focus and National 4-H Congress.
