Winter Camp

Each year 4-H members in grades 8-13 are eligible to attend winter camp at the Lindley G. Cook State 4-H Camp in Branchville, NJ. Teens take part in fun, games and friendship for the weekend with teens from other counties around the state.

South Jersey 4-H Teen Conference

South Jersey 4-H Teen Conference (SJTC) is a weekend long conferences that provides teens with the opportunity to participate in hands-on learning activities that help in the development of skills in communication, personal development, leadership, citizenship and decision-making.

NJ State 4-H Public Presentations

State 4-H Public Presentations are held in June of each year at Rutgers University. 4-H members enrolled in grades 8-13 during the current 4-H year and who receive a score of excellent on a county level presentation are eligible to attend. The event provides an opportunity for 4-H members to compete with their public presentations on the state level with 4-H members from around New Jersey.

Participants are assigned to rooms. Audience members will watch 4-H'ers speak on a wide variety of topics. The judging is done by 4-H Alumni, educators, and 4-H volunteers. The judging is based on the Danish system of judging. Each participant receives a ribbon, and the top presentation in each room receives an Outstanding Presenter Award.
