| <p>The Board of Education of the Township of Riverside in the County of Burlington, New Jersey is authorized (a) to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations, and upgrades, and to construct an addition at Riverside Elementary School, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, furniture, equipment and any site work; (b) to undertake the replacement of the roof at Riverside Middle School and the replacement of a portion of the roof at Riverside High School, including all related work; (c) to appropriate \$15,866,036 for such improvements; and (d) to issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$15,866,036. The Board may offset the amount of bonds to be issued with any state and/or federal funds or grants available at the time of the bond issuance.</p> <p>The final eligible costs for the projects approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education are \$10,194,266 (consisting of \$6,294,266 for Riverside Elementary School, \$1,950,000 for Riverside Middle School and \$1,950,000 for Riverside High School). The project includes \$0 for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage will equal 70.1104% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this election.</p> | | <p>The Board of Education of the Township of Riverside in the County of Burlington, New Jersey is authorized (a) to replace windows at Riverside High School, including any related work; (b) to appropriate \$975,000 for such improvements; and (c) to issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$975,000. The Board may offset the amount of bonds to be issued with any state and/or federal funds or grants available at the time of the bond issuance.</p> <p>The final eligible costs for the projects approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education are \$975,000. The project includes \$0 for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage will equal 70.1104% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this election.</p> | | <p>At this election, the voters of the school district are being asked to consider both Bond Proposal Question No. 1 and Bond Proposal Question No. 2. As set forth to the left, Bond Proposal Question No. 2 will only go into effect if Bond Proposal Question No. 1 is also approved by the voters at this election.</p> <p>These two proposals will authorize various improvements, alterations, renovations, and upgrades, and the construction of an addition at Riverside Elementary School, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, furniture, equipment and any site work, the replacement of the roof at Riverside Middle School, including any related work, and the replacement of a portion of the roof, and the replacement of windows at Riverside High School, including any related work. If both proposals are approved by the voters, the total cost of the projects will be \$16,841,036, and the Board will be authorized to issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$16,841,036. The Board may further offset the amount of bonds to be issued with any additional state and/or federal funds or grants available at the time of the bond issuance. These combined proposals have a total final eligible costs approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education of \$11,169,266 (consisting of \$6,294,266 for Riverside Elementary School, \$1,950,000 for Riverside Middle School and \$2,925,000 for Riverside High School). The proposed improvements include \$0 for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage will equal 70.1104% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this election.</p> |

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTERS

- To make the selection of your choice, press the box/cell containing that choice; the voting target to the right of your choice will fill with a black oval.
- To change a selection, press the box/cell marked with a vote to deselect it. The black oval will be removed, and you may make a new selection.
- If you wish to cast a WRITE-IN vote, go to the 'Personal Choice' column and press the box/cell within the contest containing the word 'Write-In'. Using the keyboard displayed, enter your write-in choice, one letter at a time. To make a correction, press the 'Delete' or 'Clear all' buttons, and re-enter your write-in choice. Once you are satisfied with your write-in choice, press the 'Confirm' button to record and display your choice. Verify your write-in choice is in the correct contest. Repeat this step for any contests you would like to cast a write-in personal choice for.
- If the ballot is double-sided, press the 'Next' button located at the bottom right corner of the screen to view the backside of the ballot for any additional contests.
- After you have made all your selections, press the 'Review' button located at the bottom right corner of the screen. Take this opportunity to complete a final review of your selections. If you would like to make a correction, press the 'Back to ballot' button located at the bottom left corner to return to the ballot and change your selections. If you are satisfied with your selections, press the 'Print' button at the bottom right corner. Press the 'Print your ballot' button to print your ballot with the selections of your choice.
- Wait until your ballot has completed printing before taking it from the printer! Double-sided ballots require two passes to complete printing.
- Remove your voter card and retrieve your ballot from the printer. Take the ballot to the tabulator for scanning and return the voter card to the Election Official.
