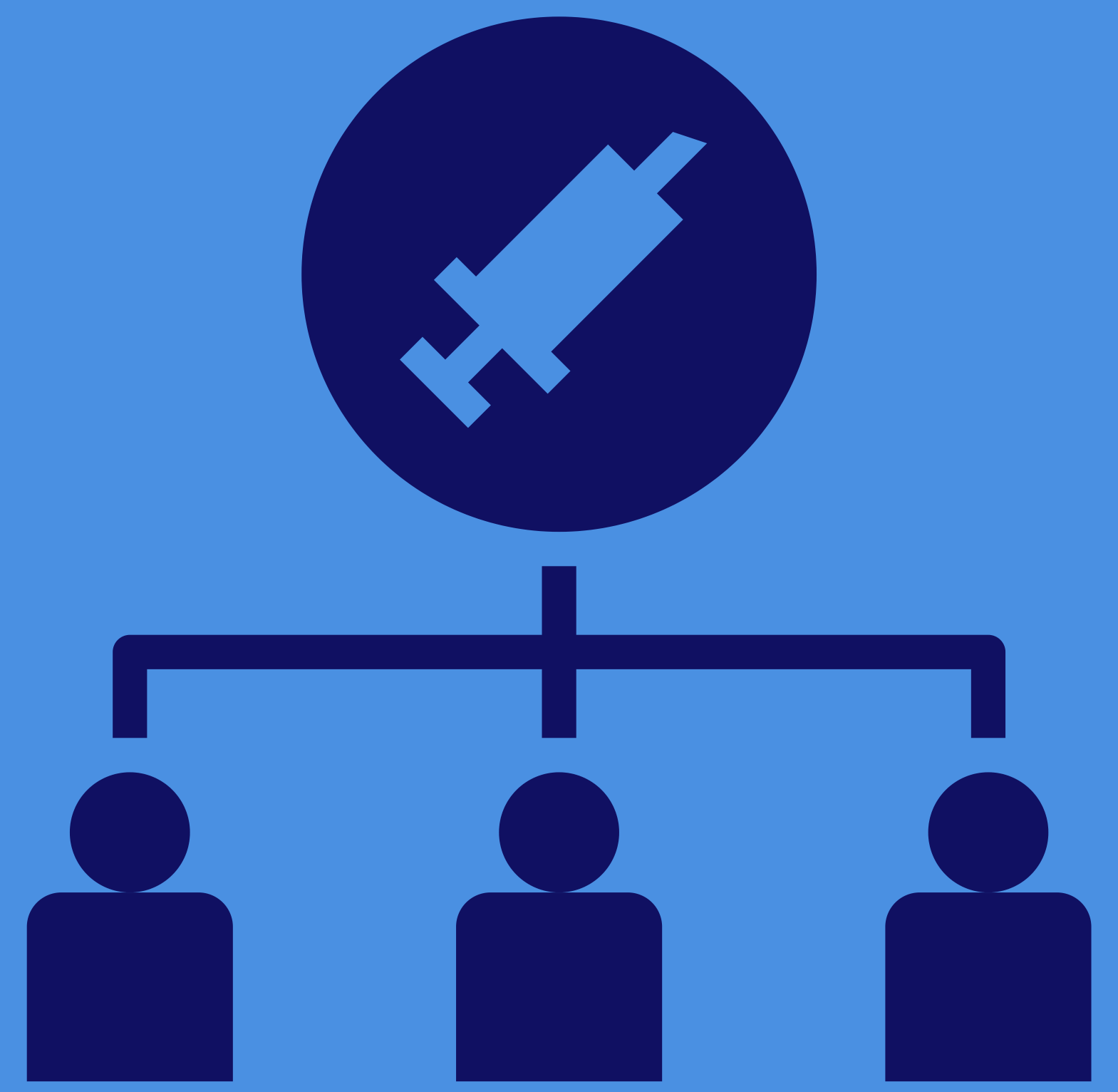

Monkeypox (mpox) Vaccination in New Jersey



Who can get vaccinated?

The vaccine for human monkeypox (mpox) virus is called JYNNEOS. In New Jersey, **the following people may be eligible for vaccination:**

- People who have known contact with someone who tested positive for orthopoxvirus or mpox virus within past 14 days

(Contact your [local health department](#) to coordinate vaccination)

- Gay, bisexual, and other men who have sex with men, transgender or nonbinary people who in the past 6 months have had:
 - A new diagnosis of one or more nationally reportable sexually transmitted diseases (i.e., acute HIV, chancroid, chlamydia, gonorrhea, or syphilis)
 - More than one sex partner
- People who have had any of the following in the past 6 months:
 - Sex at a commercial sex venue
 - Sex in association with a large public event in a geographic area where mpox transmission is occurring
- Sexual partners of people with the above risks
- People who anticipate experiencing the above risks

- People in certain occupational exposure risk groups*

*People at risk for occupational exposure to orthopoxviruses include research laboratory personnel working with orthopoxviruses, clinical laboratory personnel performing diagnostic testing for orthopoxviruses, and orthopoxvirus and health care worker response teams designated by appropriate public health and antiterror authorities. Current vaccination efforts focus on disproportionately affected groups, including gay and bisexual men, and other men who have sex with men. This may change over time.

HIGH PRIORITY GROUPS

People who are eligible for vaccination and who also have a condition that may increase their risk for severe disease should be considered high priority for vaccination, including those who:

- Have a weakened immune system
- Have a history of atopic dermatitis or eczema
