1 Hainesport: “Big Rusty” by Thomas Dambo:

Meet Big Rusty! She is a massive troll who has taken up residence at the site of Hainesport's future Creek Turn Park. A creation of internationally known artist, Thomas Dambo, the large statue was made almost entirely from recycled materials found at the abandoned Creek Turn Ceramic factory off Route 38. She serves as a homage to recycling, sustainability and the power of imagination. Find her near 1400 Rt. 38, Hainesport, NJ 08036
